Comitant to an order of the County Commissioners
Court for said county made by the Judge of the County Court and Commis-
sioners of Revenue & Roads, on the first day of September A. D. 1827, of
which the following is a copy to wit:

"It is ordered that James Thompson be appointed for
the purpose of transcribing all such papers records of the Superior
Court of said county not heretofore recorded as may be directed by the
Judge of this Court and for arranging the same in a suitable manner."

Said James Thompson has proceeded to record in this book
in pages 141 to 304, all inclusive, the marriage licenses that remain
in the office of the Clerk of said Court, on this territory, this day of Sep-
tember A. D. one thousand eight hundred and twenty three, that had
not been duly recorded, and such papers relating to said licenses as he
has been directed by the Judge of said Court to record.

William Tate " I hereby give my consent in person in the office of the
Clerk of Blount County for my son William Tate
Elizabeth Speer who is under twenty one year of age, to take out of P.
Speer a marriage license, to marry Elizabeth Speer
of said county. Alabama Territory, this 20th day of May 1818
William Tate"

"Know all men by these presents that we W^m. Tate and William Speer
County Alabama Secretary of the United States, are held and firmly bound
unto the Gov. of said Territory for the term being and his successor in office
in the sum of Two hundred dollars for the use of said Territory to the due
payment of which we hereby bind ourselves and our heirs lawfully and lawfully do set
up our hands and seal this 21st day of May 1818

The condition of the above obligation is such that - Whereas the said W^m. Tate hath
this day procured a license from the Register of the Superior Court of Blount
County to be married to Elizabeth Speer Now if there is no lawful cause to
obstruct said marriage, then the above obligⁿ to be void otherwise to remain
in force
